## **OLD BUSINESS**

### Age Rule Change

-Mike Stapp led continued discussion on the topic of age rule changes for drivers of big tractors. Mike’s proposal includes: Tractor drivers must be 19 years or older. Drivers ages 13 through 18 may compete if a written consent signed by a parent or legal guardian is presented to the Pull Officials prior to sign-up. Drivers under the age of 16 will be asked to demonstrate proficient control of their tractor (steering, clutching, stopping, and backing) and shall be supervised by an adult whenever operating a tractor at a sanctioned pull.

- Jess will contact the Mid-States’ insurance agent regarding whether our policy dictates specific age requirements before a final vote is conducted.

-Jess will check to see if our insurance agent can come to our meeting to discuss our policy with the club members reviewing limits, restrictions, and liabilities of our policy.

### Yutan Pull

-We were asked by Allan Arp to put on a Garden Tractor Pull in Yutan on the last Saturday in June. Nick Heitman made the motion to do the Yutan Pull. Keith Felthousen seconded. All Ayes.

### Fees

-Our fees were reviewed due to an error in quoting a recent event. Listed are our current fees we offer.
